Lessons Learnt on their Journey:

Support small

- ✓ Delivery apps are startups that support a number of small businesses
- ✓ Many restaurants and suppliers supported by Akeed & Azooz would not have survived the Pandemic without the reach of the apps
- ✓ "Old Fashioned" retail is being disrupted and all businesses should look at online models

Service as a product

- ✓ The product is timely service. This means that the end customer is even more critical of your company. This applies to government services as well
- ✓ Feedback should be central to all decision making

FAQs:

1. Can the market absorb multiple delivery apps?

- This evolution of delivery apps will remain because e-commerce is growing in the country. The government is giving more focus on e-commerce and supporting it. Within the rise of delivery apps, the competitors will be focusing on how to Serve their customers with the best quality.

- A marketplace to explore all apps and the best offering could be in Oman's future.
